Kids Morning Tea Duties

Morning tea commences directly after our worship service and is an integral part of the fellowship and warmth of NGPC. It is the task of the Kids Morning Tea team to help kids share and enjoy a snack together following the service.

Summary:

The kid's morning tea role consists of:

- 1 family or individual per week
- Being rostered approximately once every 3 months (4 times per year)
- Purchasing or preparing food for 40+ children prior to the worship service
- Serving the morning tea to the kids, encouraging sharing and patience
- Packing up and cleaning the kid's servery space
- Following morning tea, tidying the playground area of any rubbish or cups

Please note:

- If you are unable to take your roster turn, please contact another roster volunteer and arrange for a swap
- Food is not permitted to be eaten upstairs

Duties in more details:

- Food choices are the responsibility of the rostered family. We ask that you consider any allergy concerns the kids may have.
- Food can be homemade or purchased. We ask that you consider the quantity and sugar content of food provided.
- We would like to encourage the kids to be 'other focused' and practice sharing, waiting in line, and being respectful. Please make sure an adult is helping distribute the kid's morning tea to ensure that order is maintained.
- Please close off the kid's servery window, remove all rubbish, and wipe down the area after the kids have finished.
- Following the morning tea rush, please complete a pickup of rubbish and cups that have made their way into the playground area.
