Kids Catechism

Summary:

The morning tea role consists of:

- One Male NGPC member
- Being rostered approximately once every three months (4 times per year)
- Must have watched the video on Kid's catechism on the church website (under the resources tab).

Please note:

• If you are unable to take your roster turn, please contact another roster volunteer and arrange for a swap and let Darren know.

Duties in more detail:

To help you do this ministry well, the church has produced a brief video on how to do a Kid's catechism talk, which is available on the church website.

Preparation:

• Prepare, pray & practice

It's important you don't leave preparation till Saturday night or later! Begin early in the week by knowing the question and answer and thinking and praying about it. Once you have worked out how you will do it, make sure you practice it.

Presentation:

• Be welcoming and kind

Remember, we love children at NGPC! Try and encourage them and be warm in your demeanour.

• Be visual and engaging

Many of the children are not yet reading – so it's very important to be visual. When using props make sure they are large enough to be seen by all. Also, when using objects, keep them up high in a position that can be seen by all. Make sure your delivery is engaging and create a sense of anticipation and excitement.

• Be clear and on point

Reiterate the main point clearly so that the children are clear on what it is they are learning. Try not to over complicate things, simple is usually better.

• Be done and pray

Keep the talks shorter rather than longer and lose the children. Talks should be 4-7 mins. Once you have finished don't forget to pray. Short and simple - rephasing the main point you taught in prayer. Then introduce the children's song (make sure you know what it is).
